Phase 3 of the *North Beale Road Complete Streets / Safety Project* will primarily consist of constructing raised medians, left-turn lanes, sidewalks, paved bicycle lanes, curbs, gutters, storm drains, plus thermoplastic centerline and edge-line striping. Also included in Phase 3 will be a new traffic signal at Linda Avenue, drainage improvements, new streetlights, improvements to adjoining driveways and intersections, and an asphalt overlay.

PROJECT RATIONALE/ISSUES STATEMENT

Briefly describe the need for the project and the desired outcomes/deliverables (maximum of 200 words).

For this 2,500-foot segment, there have been ten (10) injury accidents and four (4) non-injury accidents during the period between 2017 and 2021. Two of these collisions resulted in fatalities, while two more of these collisions resulted in serious injuries. The primary project benefit will be a reduction in both injury and non-injury accidents. The project will also improve drainage throughout this section of roadway by removing the existing (undersized) roadside ditches and installing a storm drain.
